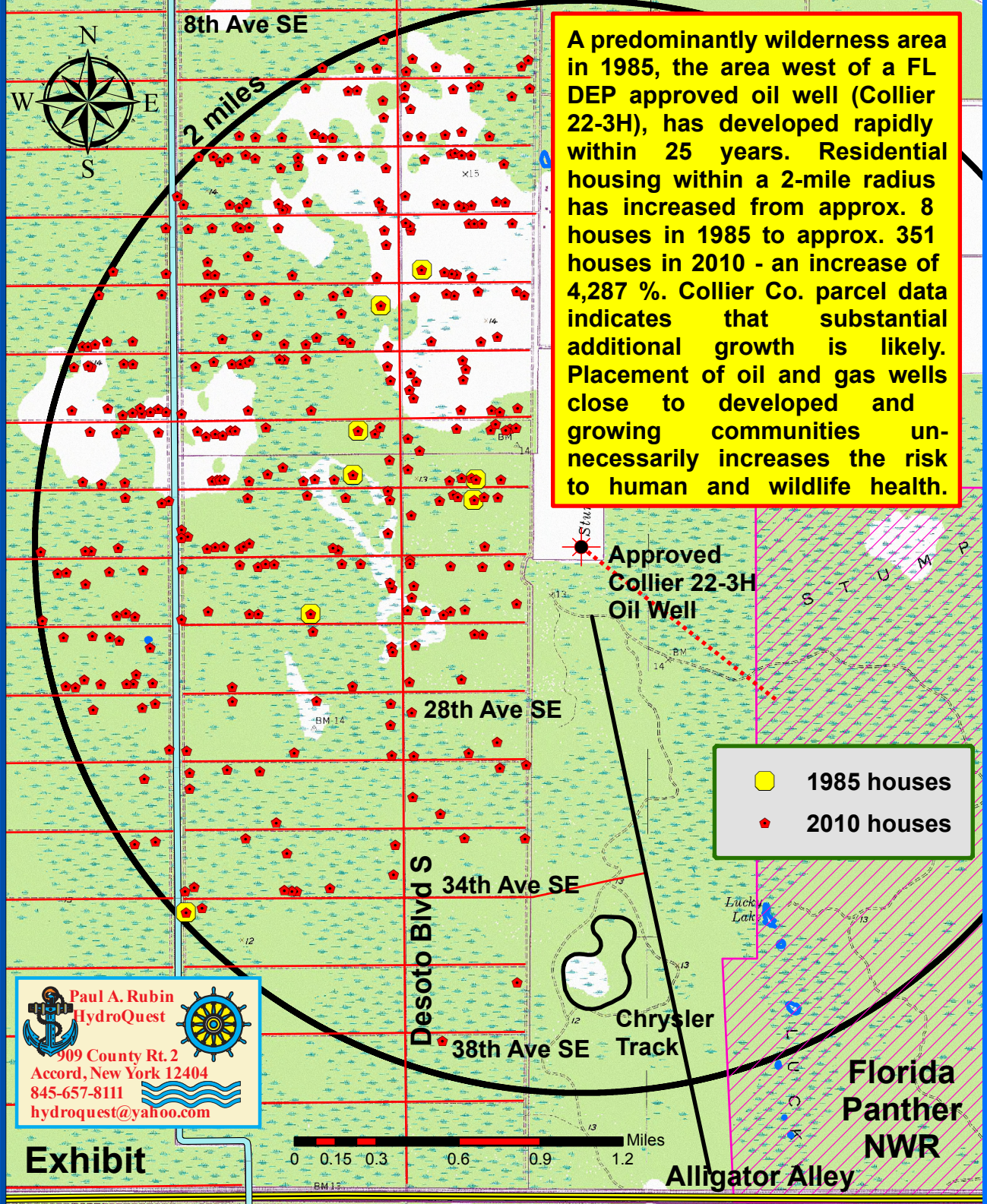



Change in Community Character - Rapid Growth of Residential Housing East of Naples, Florida: 1985 - 2010



A predominantly wilderness area in 1985, the area west of a FL DEP approved oil well (Collier 22-3H), has developed rapidly within 25 years. Residential housing within a 2-mile radius has increased from approx. 8 houses in 1985 to approx. 351 houses in 2010 - an increase of 4,287 %. Collier Co. parcel data indicates that substantial additional growth is likely. Placement of oil and gas wells close to developed and growing communities unnecessarily increases the risk to human and wildlife health.
